2026 Municipal Election

Information for Businesses and Eligible Electors

The Town of Renfrew is committed to ensuring local businesses and eligible electors have the information they need to participate in the 2026 Municipal Election.

Owning or operating a business in Renfrew does not automatically make an individual eligible to vote. However, some business owners and tenants may qualify as non-resident electors based on their property ownership or tenancy.

The information below provides a general overview of who may be eligible to vote and what business owners and tenants should know before the election.

Who Can Vote?

To vote in the 2026 Municipal Election, an individual must:

- Be a Canadian citizen;
- Be 18 years of age or older; and
- Meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - Be a resident of the Town of Renfrew;
 - Own or rent property in the Town of Renfrew; or
 - Be the spouse of an individual who owns or rents property in the Town of Renfrew.

An individual may only vote once in the Town of Renfrew, regardless of how many properties they own or rent.

Business Owners

If you personally own commercial property in the Town of Renfrew and otherwise meet the eligibility requirements, you may qualify as a non-resident elector, even if you live outside the Town.

If the commercial property is owned by a corporation, the corporation itself is not eligible to vote. Being a shareholder, director, officer or employee of a corporation does not, on its own, make an individual eligible to vote.

Business Tenants

If you personally rent commercial property in the Town of Renfrew and otherwise meet the eligibility requirements, you may qualify as a non-resident elector.



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Simply operating a business or working in the Town of Renfrew, without personally owning or renting property in the Town, does not make an individual eligible to vote.

Confirm Your Voting Eligibility

Eligible electors must be included on the Town's voters' list in order to vote.

If you're unsure whether you are eligible to vote based on your business ownership or tenancy, contact the Town Clerk before voting. The Town can confirm your eligibility and provide information about the voters' list.
