

2026 Waste Collection Information



The Town of Renfrew continues to provide Garbage and seasonal Leaf and Yard Waste collection to all properties*.

The following Holidays will impact the 2026 garbage collection schedule:



New Years Day

Thursday, January 1st - collection will occur on Friday, January 2nd.



Canada Day

Wednesday, July 1st - collection will occur on Thursday, July 2nd. **Thursday, July 2nd** - collection will occur on Friday, July 3rd.



National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

Wednesday, September 30th - collection will occur on Thursday, October 1st. **Thursday, October 1st -** collection will occur on Friday, October 2nd.



Remembrance Day

Wednesday, November 11th - collection will occur on Thursday, November 12th.

Thursday, November 12th - collection will occur on Friday, November 13th.

*Schedule changes impacting residential recycling collection will be communicated by Circular Materials and may not correspond with the garbage holiday collection schedule.



Leaf and Yard Waste collection will occur:



April 21 - 23

May 5 - 7

May 19 - 21

Fall:

October 6 - 8

October 20 - 22

November 3 -5

Leaf and Yard Waste collection will occur throughout the scheduled week and may not correspond with your garbage collection day. Please have your material out for collection by 7 am on the Tuesday of the scheduled week.


2026 Recycling Collection Information







Recycling collection for residential properties is provided and paid for by Circular Materials Ontario through a local contractor (Miller Waste Systems). The Town of Renfrew will no longer set the recycling collection schedule, provide recycling related information (including recycling calendars), or address recycling related customer service calls. Circular Materials will provide this information to properties that qualify for their curbside recycling pick up program. The Town of Renfrew may on occasion share community specific recycling related information on behalf of Circular Materials, however the best method for staying informed about your recycling collection will be through Circular Materials and their contractor.



Business & Community Organization Recycling





Recycling collection for businesses and community organizations is provided by the Town of Renfrew, separately from residential collection. This separation is required due to Provincial Regulation. For properties that are multi-use these changes only apply to the non-residential functions of the property, residential units will be serviced under the Circular Materials program. The non-residential program will accept the same material and is collected by the same contractor (Miller Waste Systems) as the residential program. However, the following changes are effective January 5, 2026:

- Curbside Recycling Collection for Businesses and Community Organizations will now occur on **Friday**.
- The following holidays fall on a Friday, on these days collection will occur 1 day early on Thursday.
 - Good Friday (Friday, April 3, 2026)
 - Christmas Day (Friday, December 25, 2026)
 - New Year Day (Friday, January 1, 2027)

Collection on Thursday

- Collection may occur as early as 7:00 a.m.
- Your garbage collection day will not change.
- Weekly cardboard collection in the downtown core will now occur bi-weekly.
- Collection type will alternate weekly from Fibre/Cardboard to Co-mingled Containers on the same schedule as the residential program. A calendar is available on request. Paper copies can be picked up from Town Hall, BIA, or Chamber of Commerce offices or can be provided digitally by email.

- Recycling can still be dropped off for free at the Renfrew Landfill, however businesses will have separate bins. If you use the landfill recycling drop off please let the landfill attendant know that you are a business or community organization so that they can direct you to the correct recycling area.
