#25.18 – Landfill Operator I (Temporary) Department of Development and Environment

The Town of Renfrew invites applications for the position of Landfill Operator I. Under the supervision of the Manager of Environmental Services, the Landfill Operator I has an important role in working with customers, directing users, responding to questions, inputting customer and waste information into the computer system and accepting payment. The position also includes involvement in daily operations of the greater landfill site including litter picking, property and building maintenance, maintaining drop-off and bins, sorting waste, performing daily inspections, reporting, assisting with operating the Household Hazardous Waste Depot, and operation of heavy equipment when required, in addition to other duties as assigned.

This is a full-time temporary position, which will be approximately six (6) months (possibility of extension). The position is 40 hours per week, Tuesday to Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with a 30 minute unpaid lunch.

Competency Profile:

- Minimum two (2) years of experience in a related environment
- Graduate of Grade 12 or equivalent
- Valid class 'G' driver's license
- Ability to obtain a clear Criminal Record Check
- Possess, working towards, or willing to obtain Basic Landfill Operator Training from SWANA
- Ability to work with the public and demonstrated customer service and interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of applicable computer systems, point of sale systems and cash handling best practices
- Experience operating heavy equipment such as a wheel loader and garbage compactor considered an asset
- Working familiarity of waste management and landfill operations and/or municipal public works
- Understanding of environmental issues that may affect a landfill and landfill compliance requirements
- Excellent problem solving, communication and organizational skills
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Health and safety knowledge regarding waste handling, heavy equipment and traffic control
