SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY #26.08 – Summer Camp Counsellor (4 positions) Department of Community & Recreation Services

Description:

The Town of Renfrew invites applications for the position of Summer Camp Counsellor to assist the Community & Recreation Services Department in supervising and ensuring the safety of campers during all Town of Renfrew Summer Camp activities. The responsibilities of this position include general supervision of children and the facilitation of activities including crafts, games, sports and day trips all while maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone. This position will be required to assist with general set-up and clean-up of program spaces, and ensuring they are safe and tidy. The availability of this position is subject to funding approval by Town Council.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in the supervision and facilitation of daily camp activities, ensuring that all campers are engaged and having fun.
- Support the Camp Leader in implementing inclusive programming and adapting activities to meet the diverse needs of campers.
- Foster a positive and welcoming environment by encouraging participation and building connections with campers.
- Help maintain a safe, clean, and organized camp space by adhering to camp policies and assisting with setup and cleanup of activities.
- Act as a role model for campers by demonstrating respect, kindness, and teamwork.
- Support campers in resolving minor conflicts and encourage positive interactions among peers.
- Report any significant concerns about camper behaviour, attendance, or health to Camp Leader promptly.
- Collaborate with Camp Leaders and fellow staff members to ensure the safety and well-being of all campers during activities, transitions, and outings.
- Promote campers' confidence, independence, and sense of belonging by encouraging their efforts and celebrating achievements.

Qualifications:

- Previous experience working with children in camp, school or recreational setting.
- Strong leadership skills and the ability to motivate and inspire campers.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Passion for working with children and creating memorable experiences in a camp setting.
- Knowledge of recreational activities such as sports, arts and crafts, nature exploration, etc.
- High school diploma or equivalent required; college coursework or degree in education, recreation or related field preferred.
- CPR and first aid certification required.
- High Five Training required.
