

Acceptable Identification for Nomination

A person filing a nomination for office must provide **one** of the following pieces of identification to verify their identity during their nomination appointment:

- a) Ontario Driver's Licence
- b) Ontario Photo Card

If the identification listed above is not available, the person filing a nomination may provide **two** pieces of identification: one (1) piece of photo identification with name and signature, and one (1) piece of identification with name and qualifying address.

Accepted Photo Identification (1 of 2)

- a) Ontario Health Card (new version with signature)
- b) Canadian Passport
- c) Firearms Licence (PAL/RPAL)
- d) Canadian Armed Forces ID Card
- e) Secure Certificate of Indian Status (SCIS)

Acceptable Identification with name and qualifying address (2 of 2)

- a) Property Tax Bill
- b) Utility Bill (hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable television)
- c) Mortgage, lease or rental statement for property in the Town of Renfrew
- d) Insurance Statement
