The new Renfrew Home Hardware Gymnasium inside the myFM Centre Recreation Complex at 1 Ma-te-Way Park Drive is ready for the community to enjoy.

The gymnasium court has painted lines for basketball, volleyball, and badminton, is approved size for competitive high school basketball and also has three rows of collapsible bleachers that can accommodate up to 144 spectators.





2024 Budget

The \$69.32 million budget was passed at the Council meeting on February 27th, 2024, and includes a tax levy of

\$11.1M for tax supported operating expenses, \$2.9M for water, \$2.7M for wastewater and \$52M in capital work. Water and sewer rates will increase by 2.5 percent with the Town portion of taxes to have a \$183.97 impact per \$100,000 in property assessment. Members of the public had the opportunity to provide comments and ask questions at the Public Budget meeting on February 20th, 2024.

Sign up for Monthly Pre-Authorized Payments

The Town of Renfrew offers pre-authorized payment plans for taxes and water/wastewater charges.

- Residents can sign up for monthly tax installments which will be split into 11 equal payments and processed each month on the 15th with the exception of December.
- Water/wastewater payments are based on actual billing and will be withdrawn on due dates shown on your bill.

A Message from the Renfrew Fire Department



Known as the invisible killer, carbon monoxide is an invisible odorless, colourless gas created when fuels (such as gasoline, wood, coal, natural gas, propane, oil, and methane) burn incompletely. CO alarms should be installed in a central location outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home and in other locations where required by applicable laws, codes or standards.

Test CO alarms at least once a month; replace them according to the manufacturer's instructions.

If the CO alarm sounds, immediately move to a fresh air location outdoors or by an open window or door.

If you need to warm a vehicle, remove it from the garage immediately after starting it. Make sure the exhaust pipe of a running vehicle is not covered with snow.
