



New Year = New Lights at the Swinging Bridge





The Town of Renfrew is excited to announce new lights have been installed along the historic Swinging Bridge. After a competitive bidding process in the fall of 2023, the Town awarded the contract to install the lights to R&R Electric, a contractor based in Renfrew.

The project was completed in December 2023.

The lights will operate on the same schedule as the streetlights in Renfrew and will illuminate at dusk and automatically turn off at sunrise. Renfrew's Swinging Bridge crosses the Bonnechere River, was built in 1885 and is located next to the McDougall Mill Museum at 65 Arthur Street.

Second Ice Pad Officially Open in Renfrew



The new ice surface at the myFM Centre in Ma-te-Way Park is officially open and ready for use.

The Icepickers, Community Living Renfrew County South's Sledge program, are honoured to be the first group to be able to test out the new ice. Members of Renfrew Town Council joined the Icepickers and staff with Community Living Renfrew County South for a ceremonial skate on Thursday, January 18th, 2024.

The expansion project is nearing the final stages. Tenants including 96.1 myFM, Renfrew Chiropractic and Rehabilitation Centre, Ultimate Fitness and Child's Paradise Day Care will begin occupying their new spaces shortly.

The gymnasium, fitness centre, dance studio and multipurpose rooms will be the next facilities to open to the public. Part of the second phase of the expansion project will see the Bonnechere Algonquin Indigenous Cultural Centre open later in 2024.

By-law #17-2000 and #18-2000 require all dogs and cats in the Town of Renfrew (including house cats) to be licensed by their owners each calendar year. Pet tags are available online at: https://renfrew.ca/pet-license-form.cfm.

Fees for pet tags increase on March 31st, 2024 and there is no cost to register a service dog.

The Town of Renfrew, requires that all dogs and cats must be licensed and wearing a tag. By licensing your dog or cat, Animal Control services will make every effort to reunite you with your lost pet. Tags are valid from January 1st to December 31st.
