- Molded plastic (e.g., storage containers, toys, flower pots) and plastic film.
 - Ceramics, glassware, mirrors, window glass, hoses.
- Metal wire, cables, metal clothing hangars, pots and pans (recycle as scrap metal at the Renfrew Landfill).
 - Empty oil containers, light bulbs and tubes, unfinished aerosols, propane cylinders (recycle at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot at the Renfrew Landfill).
