Instructor Jason Defosse conducted a full day of hands on training and is an extrication specialist who has knowledge and experience of the latest in vehicle construction and techniques.





## A Message from the Renfrew Fire Department



#### **Hunt Camp Safety**

With fall hunting season underway across Ontario, thousands of hunters are taking up temporary residence in their camps and cabins. Renfrew Fire Department is stressing the importance of smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors in all buildings where people are sleeping such as trailers, campers, buses, RVs, and mobile homes. Often hunt camps/cabins are located on remote properties that can be challenging for fire departments to reach, so this often results in

slower response times and contributes to the spread of the fire as well. The following tips will help ensure a safe, enjoyable stay at the camp or cabin:

- Ensure wood stoves and propane appliances are installed to code requirements.
- Ensure propane appliances and portable heaters are approved for indoor use.
- Keep combustibles well away from stoves and propane fire appliances.
- If it is necessary to plug extension cords into appliances, ensure it is the proper gauge and can handle the electrical load.
- Ensure there are working smoke alarms on every level, ensure that you have a working carbon monoxide alarm.
- Remember alcohol and cooking do not mix, unattended cooking is the leading cause of fires.
- Campfires for recreation or cooking must be completely extinguished to prevent a forest fire.
