



Notice of Public Open House and Statutory Public Meeting

Proposed Town of Renfrew Community Improvement Plan

TAKE NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 28 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, the Town of Renfrew will hold a **Public Open House** and a **Statutory Public Meeting** to consider a proposed new Community Improvement Project Area and Community Improvement Plan (CIP).

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the proposed CIP is to replace the Town's existing CIP, which was adopted on December 8, 2015. The proposed CIP will encourage and promote continued revitalization and private investment in the Town of Renfrew. The proposed Community Improvement Project Area and CIP will provide a set of Financial Incentive Programs to support development, redevelopment, and enhancement in the Town, including business attraction, housing, and rehabilitation of designated heritage buildings and properties.

THE SUBJECT LANDS included as part of the proposed Community Improvement Project Area and CIP include all lands within the municipal boundary of the Town of Renfrew. Accordingly, no key map is provided.

ANY PERSON may attend the Public Meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Community Improvement Project Area and CIP. Individuals making an oral submission at the Public Meeting are requested to submit a written outline to the Town Clerk.

IF A PERSON OR PUBLIC BODY would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Renfrew to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Renfrew before the by-laws are passed, that person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

IF A PERSON OR PUBLIC BODY does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Renfrew before the by-laws are passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to a hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
