





Complete the Parks and Recreation Master Plan to ensure the Town's greenspace and natural heritage assets are protected for the long-term and enjoyed by residents and visitors.	High	1-5 years
Work with the provincial and federal governments to establish an Urban Provincial Park within the Town of Renfrew with opportunities for public access and recreation.	Medium	1-10 years
Examine opportunities to increase safe and accessible public use of the Bonnechere River and its riparian areas	Medium	1-10 years
Preserve and enhance the Town's tree canopy in the public realm through the implementation of the Tree Canopy Policy.	Medium	1-10 years

Complete the Official Plan Review and Secondary Plans, including planning for infrastructure expansion in growth areas, supporting infill and redevelopment, and disposal and development of surplus Town- owned lands.	Medium	1-10 years

Update the Town's growth projections and plan accordingly to increase the Town's population to 10,000 by 2035 to support community amenities and affordability	Medium	1-5 years
Complete and implement the Waterfront Master Plan, including recommended physical and programming improvements.	Medium	1-5 years

Increase the number of lane kilometers rehabilitated within the Town of Renfrew with specific focus on local and residential roads.	Very High	1-10 years
Complete the Master Transportation Plan and Connecting Links Rehabilitation Program, and plan for the necessary integration with the 417 Highway Expansion.	High	1-10 years
Complete the Hall Avenue Extension and Ma- te-Way secondary access.	Medium	1-10 years
Continue to invest in active transportation through appropriate expansions of the Town's sidewalks, multiuse paths, trails, and other pedestrian and cycling infrastructure.	Medium	1-10 years

Continue to monitor opportunities for inter- governmental collaboration, such as advocacy on new and renewed funding programs.	Very High	1-5 years
Monitor the condition and capacity of the Town's water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure to accommodate growth and minimize service disruption through timely preventative maintenance, necessary planning and engineering, and shovel-ready projects.	Very High	1-10 years
Maintain and implement the Town's Asset Management Plan to meet legislative requirements, with a focus on the allocation of appropriate financial resources.	High	1-10 years

Provide regular reporting to Committee, Council, and the Community on matters affecting the Town's financial performance.	Very High	Now
Implement an annual workplan and annual report for the corporation, including all departments in additional to regular reporting to Committee, Council, and the Community.	High	1-5 years

Prepare for emergencies through effective public education campaigns and on-going review and implementation of the Town's Emergency Management Plan.	Medium	1-10 years
