



Town of Renfrew Special Council Meeting Summary

Renfrew County and District Health Unit Lease Agreement: The Town of Renfrew and Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) have agreed on a 10-year lease for space that is being renovated at Renfrew Town Hall. The RCDHU is expected to move into the newly renovated space in September of 2023.

Paving Projects - Park and Ride & Ma-te-Way: Council approved the paving of the park and ride at the Visitors Information Centre located at 190 Mask Road, Renfrew. Council also approved the paving of the parking lot and travel areas for the Ma-te-Way Activity Centre. The paving project at Ma-te-Way is scheduled for September of 2023 and see 121 parking spaces added. Civil work will be completed by McGrimmon Holdings Inc. with asphalt and curbs by Greenwood Paving.

Creation of Ma-te-Way Working Group: Council created the Ma-te-Way Working group to ensure the successful completion of the expansion project and assist in planning for future phases. The working group is composed of members of Council and senior staff with the Town of Renfrew. The working group will ensure effective communication and oversight on the project and will also act as a sounding board for future phases of expansion at Ma-te-Way. Councillor Jason Legris will act as Chair of the Ma-te-Way Working Group and Colliers Project Leaders will provide project management services for the completion of the expansion project.

O'Brien Road - Highway 60 Project: Council awarded the contract for engineering services on the O'Brien Road – Highway 60 Project, from Wrangler Road to Mask Road, to Jp2G Consulting Inc. in partnership with BTE. Engineering and project management costs are \$520,787.33 which is \$80,715.93 under budget. The Town of Renfrew has been provided with \$3 million in provincial funding through the Ministry of Transportation Connecting Links Program and another \$1.2 million in funding through the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund. Construction on the project is expected to begin in 2024 and the project will include the development of the first roundabout in the Town of Renfrew.
