

# Curbside Pickup

- Waste collection calendars are available at Town Hall or the Renfrew Landfill and can be accessed from the Town's Website.
- Collection day can be viewed on the waste collection area map at [www.renfrew.ca](http://www.renfrew.ca)
- Place garbage and recycling at the curbside after 6 p.m. the night before collection and **BEFORE** 7 a.m. on the day of collection.
- During winter, please do not place bags, containers or bins behind, on top, or in the side of snow banks.
- Garbage bags/containers, recycling bins and leaf and yard waste bags/ bundles must not exceed 23 kg (50 lbs) each.

## Garbage

- Two (2) bag limit per residential unit.
- Four (4) bag limit per commercial unit.
- Additional bag tags can be purchased for \$3.00 each at the Town Hall, Landfill, myFM Centre and Library.
- Maximum bag size: 26" x 32".
- Maximum container size: 67 Litres.
- Loose items must be combined and securely bagged.
- Household Hazardous waste should not be disposed of in household garbage. Information on the Household Hazardous Waste Depot is provided in the Landfill section of this pamphlet.

## Leaf and Yard Waste

- Curbside leaf and yard waste pickups occur during 3 designated weeks in the spring and fall, refer to the waste management calendar for specific weeks.
- Leaf and yard waste must be curbside before 7 a.m. on the Monday of the scheduled week. Pickups will occur throughout the week and may not correspond to garbage and recycling collection days.
- Leaf and yard waste must be in paper bags or bound bundles that do not exceed 5' in length or 2' in diameter.
- Individual branches cannot exceed 1" in diameter.
- Leaf and yard waste is accepted year round for free of charge at the Renfrew Landfill.

## Recycling

- The Recycling program is managed by a non-for profit organization called Circular Materials through a local contactor. Visit [circularmaterials.ca/Renfrew](http://circularmaterials.ca/Renfrew) to learn more.
- Recyclable material must be sorted and placed curbside based on the alternating weekly collection schedule. Mixed recyclables will not be collected.
- Recycling containers cannot be greater than 90 Litres.
- **DO NOT place recyclable material in clear plastic bags** (with the exception of fine shredded paper).
- Clean & sorted recycling is accepted at the Renfrew Landfill free of charge.

### Co-mingled (Container) Recycling

- Aluminum: cans, pie plates, trays and foil wrap.
- Glass: Clear and coloured glass food and beverage bottles, jars (must be cleaned and rinsed).
- Cartons: milk, juice and broth cartons and tetra paks.
- Plastic: Type #1 to 7 food and beverage containers, tubs and lids.
- Tin: cans, open & empty paint cans (no plastic with metal tops or bottoms and empty aerosol cans).

### Fibre Recycling (no milk or juice cartons)

- Newspapers, magazines, catalogues, flyers, brown paper bags.
- Boxboard/ paperboard: cereal boxes, tissue boxes, paper egg cartons, toilet paper rolls, paper towel rolls and etc.
- Paper: writing and computer paper.
- Cardboard (must be broken down, and left loose in a recycling bin or bundled such that it does not exceed 24" x 24" x 12" and 50 lbs.).

### NOT Recyclable (not an exhaustive list)

- Styrofoam
- Plastic film: grocery and shopping bags, outer wrap from cases of water, toilet paper, paper towels, etc.
- Ceramics, glassware and housewares.
- Flower pots, storage containers.
- Hard cover books, napkins, paper towel and food soiled cardboard.
- Metal wires, cables, clothing hangars, and pressurized containers.

# Renfrew Landfill

Located at 376 Bruce Street, Renfrew, Ontario

The Renfrew Landfill is **only open to residents of the Town of Renfrew**. Proof of residence is required.

## Fees

### Free Disposal

- Recycling
- Scrap Metal
- Household Hazardous Waste (summer only)
- Electronic Waste
- Tires
- Leaf and Yard Waste
- Branches and Brush (up to 1" in diameter)
- Christmas Trees

### Tipping Fees as of May 1, 2023

- Household Garbage bags: \$3.00 each
- Sorted waste under 200kg: \$25.00
- Sorted waste 200kg and over: \$100.00/ tonne
- Unsorted waste: \$250/ tonne
- Refrigeration appliances requiring Freon Removal: \$40.00

**The Renfrew Landfill does not accept liquid waste, hazardous waste, biological waste or asbestos.**

# Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

- The Household Hazardous Waste depot is located at the Renfrew Landfill
- HHW can be dropped off from the first Saturday in May to the last Saturday in August.
- Acceptable Household Hazardous Waste materials:
  - Paints: All types of paint including aerosol containers, stains, coatings, driveway sealers, roof coatings and non pesticide marine coatings
  - Solvents: Turpentine, disinfectants, household cleaners, bleach, oven and drain cleaners, furniture stripper, ammonia, etc.
  - Fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides and insecticides, weed killer, etc.
  - Pressurized cylinders: Propane, oxygen, helium, acetylene tanks and fire extinguisher etc.
  - Batteries: small home and automotive batteries
  - Aerosol can products
  - Light tubes and bulbs
  - Pool Cleaners
  - Used oil, oil filters, gasoline, coolant and other automotive fluids
- Maximum container size is 25 L or 50 lbs.



## Other HHW Locations

NOTE: Please call ahead before taking items to other locations to confirm collection is occurring and you meet the collection standards.

Some local options include:

- Aikenheads Drug Store, No Frills Pharmacy, Rexall Pharmacy and Walmart Pharmacy: pharmaceuticals and syringes NOTE: Syringes brought back to these locations must be stored in approved bio-hazardous containers.
- Rona Home Centre (Arnprior): Paint and light bulbs/tubes.
- Dulux Paint (Pembroke): Paint and coatings
- Small quantities of Household batteries are accepted year round at the myFM Centre, Renfrew Library, Town Hall, Canadian Tire, Rexall, and Gourley's Outdoors.

# Batteries and Cell Phones

- Household batteries weighing less than 11lbs (5 kg) and cell phones can be disposed of free of charge.
- Drop off Boxes are located at the Renfrew Landfill, myFM Centre, Town Hall, and Renfrew Library.



## Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

- Televisions, computers, monitors, computer peripherals, printers, scanners, telephones, mp3 players, cameras, radios, speakers, receivers, DVD players, video recorders and other electronic devices can be disposed of free of charge at the Renfrew Landfill.



## Tires

- Up to 10 Tires, with or without rims, per person per day can be disposed of free of charge at the Renfrew Landfill.



## Composting

- Residents are encouraged to setup a backyard composter as composting can reduce garbage by 50%.
- A one-time composter credit of \$30.00 is available per property for residents that purchase and install a composter. To obtain the credit, a proof of purchase will be required. Contact the Town Hall to inquire about the composter credit.
